Subject: VFC program update

AmeriHealth Caritas District of Columbia (“AmeriHealth Caritas DC”) received the following message from the Vaccine for Children (VFC) program.

Dear DC VFC Providers:

All providers that are scheduled to order VFC vaccines in December must submit orders/requests in VTrckS and/or on paper by the close of business on **December 13, 2016** in order to guarantee shipment or to receive vaccines in December 2016. Orders/requests that are not submitted by 12/13/2016 may not be shipped prior to **January 4, 2017**.

There will be no VFC vaccine deliveries on the following dates:

- December 23 through December 27, 2016.
- January 2 through January 4, 2017.

Please notify the VFC immediately, if your office/practice will be closing at any time during the days and hours that the VFC has on file for delivering vaccines to your practice. You may be responsible for replacing at your cost, vaccines that are compromised due to delivery failures resulting from closure during shipment hours that have been provided to the VFC Program.
