One of the most promising ways to provide integrated care is the coordination of physical health and behavioral health services in primary care to meet the needs of patients. In this introductory workshop, participants will review the patient centered medical home with integrated primary care and learn the value of behavioral health services delivered within integrated settings. The course will include methods of universal screening, assessment strategies to facilitate collaboration, measurement based care and functional assessment.

Following this workshop, participants will be able to define the patient centered medical home, the quadruple aim, the role of the behavioral health practitioner on a primary care team and identify the most common screening measures for adult & child behavioral difficulties. Participants will also become familiar with specific brief intervention skills necessary for practice in a primary care setting.
